

## NEW STUDENT-TO-SCHOOL-COUNSELOR RATIOS

According to the latest data from the U.S. Department of Education, the national student-to-school-counselor ratio was 376:1 in 2023–2024, compared to 385:1 the previous school year, representing a 2% improvement year over year. With this new ratio, approximately 1,086,643 more students had access to a school counselor in the 2023–2024 school year compared to the previous school year.


